The petitioner has preferred this application for grant

of regular bail in connection with Parasbigha P.S. Case No. 113

of 2023 dated 29.03.2023 registered for the offences punishable

u/s 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

As per the prosecution case, total 50 litres of illicit

country made liquor was recovered from the bank of Dardha

River, where the *bhatti* was being operated.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that



the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner is accused in four other criminal cases as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 01.04.2023.

Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Jehanabad in connection with Parasbigha P.S. Case No. 113 of 2023.

The application stands allowed.
