APP for the State.

2. The petitioners apprehend arrest in connection with
Kinjar P.S. Case No. 92 of 2020 dated 20.12.2020 instituted for
offence punishable under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 324,
308, 379, 504 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per the prosecution case, the accused persons
reached the house of the informant with *lathi*, *danda* and *iron*
rod and assaulted the informant and his family members.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that



they are innocent and have falsely been implicated in this case. Petitioners and informant are co-villagers and there is land dispute between the parties. Injuries to all the injured are simple in nature. The petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

5. Learned APP opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and submissions of learned counsel for the parties, in the event of arrest or surrender before the Court below within six weeks from today, the petitioners above named be released on bail upon furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-1, Arwal in connection with Kinjar P.S. Case No. 92 of 2020, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.
