seeking the following relief:-

*“1. That this is an application for issuance
of an appropriate writ/writs,
direction/directions, directing the
Respondent to cancel/withdraw the
license bearing license No. 6 of 2017 of*



Rifle bearing Rifle No.91-AB, 0236 issued by Respondent No. 7 to Respondent No. 12 in a very illegal and erroneous manner even without following rules and norms of law and even without considering criminal antecedent of Respondent No. 12.”

At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies, as are otherwise available under the law, for redressal of the aforesaid grievances. Liberty so sought is granted.

The writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
