ORAL ORDER

3 22-03-2023 In compliance to the earlier order of this Court dated 16.8.2018, passed in CWJC No. 10256 of 2004, it has been submitted that the petitioner has already been granted the benefits of GPF, group insurance, leave encashment, provisional pension and provisional gratuity, apart from him being paid arrears of salary, hence, the learned counsel for the contemnors has submitted that the order of this Court, disobedience whereof has been complained of, has been complied with substantially.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the monetary benefits on account of grant of ACP has not been



granted to the petitioner, hence, the petitioner be granted liberty to agitate his grievance regarding non-payment of the same before the concerned authorities. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

The contempt petition stands disposed off as not pressed.
