3 13-12-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and State.

2. The petitioner apprehends her arrest in a case registered for the offence under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120(B) of the Indian Penal Code.

3. The petitioner is alleged to have obtained appointment, as Panchayat Teacher, on the basis of forged and fabricated B.T.E.T. Certificate.

4. It is submitted on behalf of petitioner that petitioner was appointed, as Panchayat Teacher, after investigation of all her educational certificates by the concerned department, but later on, B.T.E.T. certificate has been declared as forged and fabricated without proper verification or giving any notice to the petitioner. Moreover, petitioner has already been terminated from service by the order of Panchayat Secretary, Parsauni,



Baikunthpur, District - Gopalganj, as contained in Memo No. 15 dated 08.12.2022. Copy of the said letter is annexed with this file at flag 'R'.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State vehemently opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the above named petitioner, in the event of his arrest/surrender before the court below within a period of six weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate-VII, Gopalganj in connection with Mohammadpur P.S. Case No. 285 of 2022, subject to condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
