Re. MJC No. 3857 of 2018

As per submission of the learned counsel for the respondent - Bihar State Food and Civil Supplies Corporation (for brevity' the Corporation) an amount of Rs. 4,61,022.00 (Four Lakh Sixty One Thousand and Twenty Two) being the petitioner's due wages outstanding has been authorized for payment through CFMS/PFMS/RTGS under order dated 24.04.2023, bearing Memo No. 3230 issued by the Deputy General Manager, Administration of the respondent-Corporation. The arrears difference arising out of 5th and 6th pay revision have also been paid in terms of communication date 18.04.2023, bearing memo no. 459 issued by the District Manager of the respondent- Corporation.

The petitioner's counsel submits that the payments are subject to verification and, if any discrepancy is found, the



petitioner would be at liberty to assail the same.

With liberty, as submitted, the contempt application is
disposed of.
