2 24-06-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 30(a) and 37 of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

600 litres of illicit country made liquor has been recovered from a Tata Magic vehicle.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the present case. It is submitted that the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent as stated in paragraph-3 of the bail application. It is further submitted that there is no recovery from the conscious possession of the petitioner. It is submitted that the petitioner is made accused in the present case as he is the



owner of the said vehicle.

Petitioner is agree to deposit a sum of Rs. 25,000/- (rupees twenty five thousand) in the account of Patna High Court Legal Services Committee, Patna, bearing Account No.1413010060836, IFSC Code: PUNB141320, Punjab National Bank, Bar Council Branch, Patna.

Taking into consideration the fact that there is no recovery from the conscious possession of the petitioner, let petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of six weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (rupees twenty five thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Exclusive Special Excise Court No.,1st, Bhojpur, Ara in connection with Barahara P.S. Case No.689 of 2022, subject to the conditions laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure as well as subject to the further conditions that:

(i) One of the bailors will be his own blood relative, preferably, father, mother, brother, sister and/or his wife.

(ii) The petitioner shall not indulge himself in any similar offence till conclusion of the trial.

The bail bond of the petitioner shall be accepted by



the learned court below on showing receipt of deposit of the
aforesaid amount in the account of Patna High Court Legal
Services Committee, Patna.
