ORAL ORDER

6 08-09-2023 Heard Mr. Sri Niwas Jha, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. Shashi Shekhar Tiwari, learned counsel representing the State. Mr. S. S. Sundram, representing the Bihar Sanskrit Shiksha Board, is present.

2. After some argument, learned counsel for the petitioner fairly submits that so far the grievance of the petitioner is concerned, the same has been redressed and the benefit of pay revision for the period 01.01.1996 till date of his superannuation has already been paid. However, he seeks liberty



to file a fresh application before the authority concerned for interest over the delayed payment.

3. In view thereof, the present contempt application stands disposed of.

4. It is needless to observe that the petitioner is at liberty to approach before the authority concerned, if any grievance is still subsist.
