3 27-06-2023 Though the present writ petition was filed for grant of ex gratia compensation to the tune of Rs. 4,50,000/- on account of the husband of the petitioner having died due to COVID-19 infection, however, the learned counsel for the respondent-State has filed a counter affidavit which has been taken on record, from which it is apparent that the said sum of Rs. 4,50,000/- has already been paid to the petitioner, hence it is submitted that the



present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.
