2 07-07-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

Petitioner apprehends arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under section 498A of the Indian Penal Code.

It is a case of torture and harassment for dowry.

Petitioner is husband of the victim and denies the allegation. It is averred in paragraph 12 of the bail petition that the petitioner is already paying interim maintenance of Rs.3500/- per moth to the victim as per direction of the Family Court, Beguserai in Maintenance Case No. 45M/2020.

Considering the aforesaid facts of the case, prayer for bail of the petitioner is allowed. In the event of arrest/surrender within six weeks from today, let the petitioner, mentioned



above, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Beguserai in Complaint Case No. 699C/2020, subject to the conditions laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
