The petitioner has preferred this application for grant

of regular bail in connection with Complaint Case No. 3152 of

2014 dated 12.12.2014 registered for the offences punishable u/s

498A of the Indian Penal Code.



As per the prosecution case, the petitioner and the other co-accused persons are alleged to have assaulted and tortured the complainant due to non-fulfilment of demand of Rs. 5 lakh as dowry. Further, they ousted her from the matrimonial home and the husband contracted second marriage.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. There is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioner. The petitioner neither demanded dowry nor tortured the complainant. The petitioner is the husband of the complainant. The petitioner has got clean antecedent as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 3.4.2023.

Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Katihar in connection with Complaint Case No. 3152 of 2014.



The application stands allowed.
