marks out of minimum qualifying marks as 81 marks.3. Learned counsel for the Bihar School Examination
Board submits that the matter relates to B.E.T.E.T., 2017 and
this writ application has now become infructuous in view of the
fact that after 2017, the Bihar School Examination Board has |
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conducted B.E.T.E.T. in the year 2019 and 2021 also.
