- 2      02-08-2023                      1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and  
learned A.P.P. for the State.
2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case  
registered for the offences punishable under Sections 341, 323,  
324, 379, 307 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.
3. The informant alleges that the accused persons  
including the petitioner came at his shop and assaulted his son  
and snatched Rs. 5,000/- along with a golden ring.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the  
petitioner is a person with clean antecedent.
5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the  
petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case, it is  
next submitted that on intervention of well wishers, the matter



has been compromised between the parties as would be evident from Annexure-2 to the anticipatory bail application.

6. Learned A.P.P. for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner.

7. Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner above-named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned trial court within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court where the case is pending/successor court in connection with Muffasil P.S. Case No. 779 of 2022 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
