2 05-07-2023 Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to
remove defect (s), as pointed out by the office, if any, within a
period of four weeks on resumption of physical mode.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P for the State.

The petitioner has preferred this application for grant
of regular bail in connection with Kewati P.S Case No. 145 of
2018 dated 28.08.2018 registered for the offences punishable u/s
30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

As per the prosecution case, total 158.4 litres of illicit
liquor was recovered from the car.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that
the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this



case. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner is not the owner of the said car. The petitioner was not apprehended on the spot. The petitioner is accused in two other criminal cases as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 04.01.2023.

Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Darbhanga in connection with Kewati P.S. Case No. 145 of 2018.

The application stands allowed.
