counsel for the State.

Petitioner apprehends arrest in connection with
Harshidhi P.S. Case No. 01 of 2022 registered for the offences
under Sections 302 and 120B of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is not named in the FIR and he has been falsely
implicated in the instant case due to ulterior motive of the
informant. Further submission is that the deceased had died due
to train accident and the petitioner has no concern with the
aforesaid accident. It is also submitted that the petitioner has no
criminal antecedent.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case
and the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties, the



petitioner, above named is directed to be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing personal bond to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, East Champaran at Motihari in connection with Harshidhi P.S. Case No. 01 of 2022, subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
