A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 341, 323, 504, 379, 354, 307/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. Allegation against the petitioner is that he along with other accused persons assaulted the informant's side with deadly weapons.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. The allegation levelled against the petitioner is not specific rather general and omnibus in nature. He submits that there is case and counter case between the parties and both sides have sustained grievous injury. Similarly situated co-



accused been enlarged on bail by this Court vide order dated 31.07.2023 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 37423 of 2023. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent as mentioned in para-3 of this application.

5. Learned APP for the State opposes prayer for anticipatory bail.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner, be released on bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court below where the case is pending/successor Court in connection with Obra P.S. Case No. 533 of 2022, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
