ORAL ORDER

2 20-12-2023 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief:-

“1. That by the writ application, the petitioner seeks indulgence of this hon'ble Court for issuance of an appropriate writ or writs, direction or directions commanding the respondents to consider and make payment of entire arrear salary during the suspension period i.e. from 6-01-2018 to 31-7-2020 in the light of Bihar Service Code, Bihar Pension Rules and law settled by the Hon'ble Court in Full Bench.”

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the
