2 20-12-2023 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following reliefs:-

“1(i). For the issuance of an appropriate writ in quashing the Memo Nos. 1516/16-17 and 1517/16-17 dated 13.1.2017, issued by the Project Manager, the Women Development Corporation, Bihar (Department of Social Welfare, Government of Bihar), whereby and whereunder the candidature of the petitioners for the appointment



of Advisor has been refused to consider (Annexure-6 & 6/A).

(ii). For the issuance of an appropriate writ commanding the respondent authorities to consider and appoint the petitioners on the post of Advisor in Women Helpline, Bhagalpur pursuant to advertisement letter no. 1105/2013-14 dated 10.10.2013.”

2. After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioners seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioners to approach the Respondents authorities for redressal of their subsisting grievances, if any. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

3. The present writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
