7 03-04-2023 Heard Mr. Vijay Kumar Singh, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner and Mr.S.Raza Ahmad, learned AAG 5 appearing on behalf of the respondents.

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present writ petition to enable him to make a detailed representation in support of his



claim, in light of the judgment passed by the Hon'ble Full Bench of this Court in *Amerika Devi & Ors. Vs. The State of Bihar & Ors. (CWJC NO.10063 of 2012)* case reported in *2019 (4) PLJR 354*.

3. Learned counsel further informs that the sole petitioner has died during the pendency of the writ petition and such liberty may be directed to be availed by the wife of the petitioner, who is entitled to claim her family pension.
