2 28-06-2023 Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to remove defect (s), as pointed out by the office, if any, within a period of four weeks on resumption of physical mode.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Nabinagar P.S. Case No. 106 of 2023 dated 14.3.2023 registered for the offences punishable u/s 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

As per the prosecution case, 207.360 litres of liquor is alleged to have recovered from a Bolero vehicle. The petitioner with other co-accused persons was apprehended on the spot.



Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner is not the owner of the vehicle. The petitioner has got clean antecedent as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 15.3.2023.

Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Aurangabad in connection with Nabinagar P.S. Case No. 106 of 2023.

The application stands allowed.
