2. The petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in connection
with Complainant Case No. 286 of 2022 District- Kaimur at
Bhabua registered for the offence punishable under Sections
323, 341, 498(A) of the Indian Penal Code and Section 3/4 of
the Dowry Prohibition Act.

3. As per the allegation made by the wife of the
petitioner, the petitioner had started demanding motorcycle as
dowry after few months of marriage and for non-fulfillment of
the same, he had started torturing her.



4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submitted that petitioner is ready to live along with the complainant, who is his legally wedded wife and he will also fulfill all physical and financial requirement and he will file an affidavit to that effect before the Court below. Petitioner has clean antecedent. On these grounds, petitioner seeks to be released on pre-arrest bail.

5. Learned APP for the State submitted that the matter relates to dispute between husband and wife and that can be resolved amicably.

6. Considering the nature of allegation made against the petitioner, the petitioner is directed to file an affidavit making specific undertaking that he is ready to keep the complainant, who is his legally wedded wife with full dignity and honour and will also fulfill all physical as well as financial requirement to her.

7. In case such affidavit is filed, the petitioner, above named, is directed to be released on pre-arrest bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial

condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
