prayed for following relief:-

"1. That the present Civil Writ application is being filed for release of vehicle/Bolero ZLX Mahindra Registration No. BR01PG5067 Chesis No. MA1XX2GPKG5E64820, Engine No. GPG4D63015, belong to the petitioner which has been seized by Bheja P.S. Case No. 41/2023, dated 10.05.2023 for alleged offences registered Under



Section 272, 273/34 of the I.P.C 30(a)/47 Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act 2018 the aforesaid case pending in the Court of Ld. A.D.J.-II- Cum-Special Judge, Excise Act- Madhubani, confiscation proceeding has not been initiated against the said seized bolero.
