A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 366, 366(a)/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per the prosecution case, it is alleged that all the F.I.R. named accused persons enticed informant's niece and kidnapped her with an intention to marry her.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. The allegation levelled against the petitioner is not specific rather general and omnibus in nature. He submits that the victim in her statement under Section 164 of the Cr.P.C., has not supported the prosecution case. He further submits that



the victim girl is living at the house of the petitioner. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent as mentioned in para-3 of this application.

5. Learned APP for the State opposes prayer for anticipatory bail.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner, be released on bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court below where the case is pending/successor Court in connection with Harnaut P.S. Case No. 90 of 2022, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
