1 of CPC read with Section 114 of CPC.



3. Recently, Apex Court in the case of *S. Murali Sundaram v. Jothibai Kannan & Ors.*, in *Civil Appeal No. 1167-1170 of 2023 (para 14 to 17)*, held that review petition could be entertained only if there is any error apparent on the face of the record.

4. In the light of these facts and circumstances, the present Civil Review petition stands dismissed.
