1. Heard learned counsel for the parties.

2. The petitioner has filed the present writ application

According to the petitioner, the petitioner has been working as
Prakhand teacher at middle school, Belha under the District of
Saharsa.

District Appellate Authority has been constituted for redressal of grievances of the *Panchayt* Block Teachers and the petitioner has approached this Court directly instead of filing appeal before the District Appellate Authority.
