7 25-09-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the respondents-High Court.

2. In view of the grievance of the petitioner regarding the order dated 05.10.2020 issued by the Office of the Judge In-Charge (Administration), Civil Court, Bagaha, being without assigning any reasons, learned counsel for the respondents submits that the order will be passed afresh, after due regard to the petitioner's reply dated 28.09.2020 (Annexure-11 to the writ petition).

3. Since the order is to be passed afresh, no further direction or order is required to be issued by this court.

4. Let fresh order be issued showing due



consideration of the petitioner's reply within a period of eight (8) weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order.

5. Before passing final order, it is needless to say that the authorities should not proceed with further recoveries in terms of order dated 05.10.2020.

6. Writ application is accordingly disposed of.
