*participate in the tender process along with other bidders in pursuant to NIT No: BPC/ER/BR/POL/BULK/BNI/2017-21/01 and award the same in accordance with law or to quash the NIT No: BPC/ER/BR/POL/BULK/BNI/2017-21/01 by which quotation was invited for namely:- Tank Lorry requirement for road transportation of Bulk Petroleum Products. Bearing Tender no: BPC/ER/BR/POL/BULK/BNI/2017-21/01, by the respondents through E tender.*

*II. For any other relief or reliefs for which the petitioner is entitled under law in the facts and circumstances of the present case.”*

Perusal of the records, it is evident that there is no interim order, therefore, one has to draw inference that subject matter of NIT has already spent its force.

Hence, the present petition does not survive for consideration, accordingly, writ petition stands disposed of as it has become infructuous.
