ORAL ORDER

2 20-07-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Fulwaria P.S. Case No. 157 of 2022 dated 15.09.2022 registered for the offences punishable u/ss 120B, 307 read with section 34 of the Indian Penal Code and section 27 of the Arms Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, some unknown miscreants fired on the informant's son on his back due to which he got severely injured.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. The petitioner is not named in the FIR. The name of



the petitioner has sprung up in the confessional statement of the co-accused Yuvraj Kumar @sonu. The petitioner has got four other criminal cases as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 22.10.2022.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Begusarai in connection with Fulwaria P.S. Case No. 157 of 2022 with the condition/s:-

(i). The petitioner is directed to remain physically present before the learned Court below on each and every date, failing which on two consecutive dates without reasonable cause, the bail bond of the petitioner is liable to be cancelled.

7. The application stands allowed.
