*“1.(i) For commanding the respondent
authorities to take appropriate steps to quash
the notice issued under Section 6(1) of the
Bihar Lok Bhumi Encroachment Act 1956,
dated 06.06.2023, in Encroachment Case
No.2/23-24, pertaining to Khata No.-124,
Khesra No.-740.*

*(ii) For commanding the respondent authorities
to take appropriate steps to drop the notice,
issued under Lok Bhumi Encroachment Act
1956, under Section 6(2) in connection with
Encroachment Case No.2/23-24.*



(iii) For commanding the responding authority to stay the notice dated 06.06.2023, issued in Case No.- 02/23-24.”
