2 28-04-2023 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following relief:-

“1.That this is an application for issuance of a writ of mandamus or any other appropriate writ/order/ direction commanding respondents to take appropriate penal action against Shri Kameshwar Sharma, a Sub- Inspector of Police who was investigating officer of Shri Krishnapuri P.S. Case No. 223 of 2017 registered on 21.08.2017 U/S 120B, 384, 419, 420, 467, 468 & 471 of the I.P.C. for



dishonestly retaining the record of said case.”

At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law, for redressal of her aforesaid grievances. Liberty so sought is granted.

The writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
