2 28-04-2023 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief:-

“1. That the present writ petition is being filed for direction upon the Respondents No. 2 and 3, for conducting an enquiry for the irregularities which is being committed in the offence of Dumraon Nagar Parishad, Dumraon, District-Buxar, in purchasing the dustbin, contrary to the direction passed by the National Green Tribunal, New Delhi, in O.A. No. 606 of 2018.”



After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

The writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
