2 28-04-2023 The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner had challenged the order dated 18.03.2016, passed by the District Magistrate, Patna by filing Arms Appeal No. 64 of 2016, before the learned Court of Divisional Commissioner, Patna, who by an order dated 28.05.2019/ 29.06.2019, had remanded the matter back to the District Magistrate, Patna for re-consideration, however, till date the District



Magistrate, Patna has not passed any final order, hence, a direction be issued to the District Magistrate, Patna to dispose off the aforesaid pending case, within a stipulated time frame.
