ORAL ORDER

9 16-03-2023 This Civil Revision Application is directed against the judgment and decree dated 23.03.2022 passed by the learned Civil Judge (Junior Division) Munsif, Biharsharif in Title Eviction Suit No. 08 of 2013 filed by the plaintiff opposite party under Sections 11(c) and 11(e) of the Bihar Buildings (Lease Rent and Eviction), Control Act, 1982 against the defendant.

After hearing counsel for the parties at the time of argument of the case when the revision application was likely to



be dismissed, learned counsel for the petitioners requested for 8 months time to vacate the premises. This Court finds it appropriate. In the fact and circumstances of the case, the learned counsel for the opposite party agrees to the aforesaid proposal.
