2 12-07-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned APP.

2 The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Chausa PS Case No 295 of 2022 dated 30.12.2022 registered for the offence punishable under Sections 20, 22, 23, 24 of the NDPS Act.

3 As per the prosecution case, 1.300 gms of Ganja was recovered from the bag of the petitioner.

4 Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. The seized contraband is not of commercial quantity. The petitioner bears clean antecedent, as stated in paragraph 3 of the bail petition. He is in custody in this case since



31.12.2022.

5 Learned APP has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6 Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, the period of custody as well as the nature of allegation against the petitioner, the petitioner above named is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bonds of Rs 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Sessions Judge, Madhepura in Chausa PS Case No 295 of 2022 dated 30.12.2022.

7 This application stands allowed.
