remove all the defects pointed out by the office within one

month.

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner as well as

the learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with

Munger Kotwali (Basudeopur) P.S. Case No. 119 of 2022,

registered for offence punishable under sections 147, 149, 447,

341, 323, 325, 385, 505 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code and

Section 27 of the Arms Act.

As per allegation, the accused persons assaulted the

members of informant side and demanded ransom.

The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted



that there is election rivalry between the parties and Vijay Yadav, the father of the petitioner, was Ward Councilor at the time of incident. He has also submitted that though there is allegation of firing, but no fire arm injury has been found on the person of the injured. The injuries are simple in nature.

Considering the above-mentioned facts and circumstances, the petitioner above-named, in the event of his arrest or surrender, within four weeks from today, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Munger in connection with Munger Kotwali (Basudeopur) P.S. Case No. 119 of 2022, subject to condition as laid down under section 438(2) Cr. P.C.

Office shall ensure that all defects are removed by the petitioner within the stipulated time mentioned hereinabove, failing which, the matter shall be brought to the notice of this Court.
