3 10-01-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned APP
for the State and perused the case diary.

The petitioner is in custody in a case registered for the
offence punishable under Sections 366A/34 of the Indian Penal
Code.

Allegedly, it is a case of dowry death due to non-
fulfilment of dowry demand.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. He further
submits that the deceased died due to committing suicide. He
further submits that the marriage of the deceased performed in
the year 2015 and blessed with three children. There is no
consistent evidence that the petitioner had demanded dowry,



harassed and misbehaved with the deceased due to non-fulfilment of said dowry demand and the cause of death is asphyxia due to hanging. Petitioner is in custody since 05.02.2022.

Learned APP appearing for the State has opposed the prayer for regular bail.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned SDJM, Sikarashtra at Dhaka, East Champaran in connection with Ghorasahan (Jharokhar) P.S. Case No. 56 of 2022.
