“1.That the present writ application is being filed for direction upon Respondents for conducting an enquiry for the irregularities which has been committed in the office of Dumraon Nagar Parishad, Dumraon, District-Buxar, in connection with issuance of tender and allotment of work to private respondent



namely PBS Facilities Management, Pvt. Ltd., who is not eligible in terms of the condition mentioned in the N.I.T.”

At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law, for redressal of the aforesaid grievances. Liberty so sought is granted.

The writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
