A.P.P. for the State.

Petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with
Jaynagar P.S. Case No.19 of 2021 registered under Section 302
I.P.C. and other allied sections of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that
similarly situated co-accused persons have already been granted
bail by a coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated
24.01.2022 passed in Cr.Misc.No.35318 of 2021 (Annexure 3).

Having considered the fact that similarly situated co-
accused persons have been granted bail vide Annexure 3, let the



above named petitioners be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of C.J.M., Madhubani in connection with Jaynagar P.S. Case No.19 of 2021, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
