ORAL ORDER

- 2 17-08-2023 1. Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to remove defect (s), as pointed out by the office, if any, within a period of four weeks on resumption of physical mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned A.P.P. for the State.
3. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with N.D.P.S. Case No. 8 of 2020 arising out of Islampur P.S. Case No. 156 of 2020 dated 15.03.2020 registered for the offences punishable u/s 22 of the N.D.P.S. Act.
4. As per the prosecution case, 2.5 Kg ganja was



recovered from the house of the petitioner.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has no concern with the alleged recovery. The seized contraband is not of commercial quantity. The petitioner is accused in four other criminal cases which are not of similar nature as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The co-accused person has already been granted bail by the co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 24.11.2020 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 30866 of 2020. The petitioner is in custody since 23.09.2022.

6. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

7. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Nalanda at Biharsharif in connection with N.D.P.S. Case No. 8 of 2020 arising out of Islampur P.S. Case No. 156 of 2020.



8. The application stands allowed.
