2.Let the defect(s), if any, be removed within a
period of four weeks from today.

3.The petitioners seek bail in connection with
Matihani P.S. Case No. 18 of 2023 registered for the offence
under Sections 25(1-B)A/26/35 of the Arms Act.

4.Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that
the petitioners are in custody since 09.02.2023 and they are
quite innocent and have not committed any offence.

5.Learned A.P.P. has vehemently opposed the
prayer for bail and he has submitted that the petitioner no. 1 has



13 criminal antecedents and petitioner no. 2 has five criminal antecedents.

6.Considering the criminal antecedents of the petitioners, I am not inclined to grant bail to the petitioners.

7.Accordingly, this application stands rejected.

8.The District Judge, Begusarai is directed to get the trial expedited in which the petitioners are accused.
