7 10-07-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the State along with the learned counsel for the
informant.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case
registered for the offences punishable under Sections 420, 376,
506 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the informant, at the outset,
submits that this is the second anticipatory bail application of
the petitioner and since a compromise has been entered after
intervention of well wishers as the occurrence of rape was not
committed, as such, the informant does not oppose the second
anticipatory bail application of the petitioner.

Considering the submissions made by the learned



counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner above-named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned trial court within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court where the case is pending/successor court in connection with Aurangabad P.S. Case No. 15 of 2020 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
