- 2 08-08-2023 1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and
learned A.P.P. for the State.
2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case
registered for the offences punishable under Sections 420, 467,
468, 471, 34 of the Indian Penal Code.
3. The informant alleges that 417 candidates
including the petitioner submitted fake and forged certificate in
pursuance of an advertisement issued for appointment on the
post of Junior Engineer.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is a person with clean antecedent.
5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case, it is
next submitted that the FIR came to be instituted in haste



without holding any inquiry, it is also submitted that had an opportunity been given to the petitioner to explain his side of the case, perhaps, the present FIR would not have been instituted, it is also submitted that the petitioner has not been appointed on the post of Junior Engineer.

6. Learned A.P.P. for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner.

7. Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner above-named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned trial court within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court where the case is pending/successor court in connection with Sachiwalay P.S. Case No. 39 of 2023 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
