ORAL ORDER

2 05-07-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case
registered for the offences punishable under Sections 30(a) and
30(c) of the Bihar Excise Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is a person with clean antecedent and allegation is of
recovery of 150 litres of liquor from a forest area along with
4000 litres of *mahua* solution which was destroyed at the spot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner was not apprehended from the spot as such nothing
was recovered from his conscious possession and he came to be
implicated at the instance of local people but then the FIR does



not disclose the name of the local people who disclosed the name of the petitioner. It is further submitted that even the alleged recovery is from a place which is accessible to public at large and the petitioner is a person with clean antecedent.

Learned A.P.P. for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner.

Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner above-named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 1,000/- (Rupees One Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/successor court in connection with Excise P.S. Case No. 101 of 2023 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
