learned counsel for the State.

Petitioner in the present case has questioned the order
of suspension as contained in Memo No. 3105 dated
13.07.2016.

This Court has been informed that by the impugned
order, a disciplinary proceeding was initiated against the
petitioner and during pendency of the writ application, the said
disciplinary proceeding has already been concluded wherein the



petitioner has been served with a punishment of dismissal from service.

It is stated that the order of dismissal has been separately challenged in CWJC No. 15706 of 2021 which is pending before this Court.

Learned counsel for the State submits that in such circumstance, this application has become infructuous.
