APP for the State.

The petitioner has prayed for regular bail in a case registered for the offence punishable under section 392 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the three miscreants is that they snatched the bag of the informant containing 2,89,000/- on the point of pistol while the informant was returning from his motorcycle after collecting arrears from his clients.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. He has falsely been implicated in this case merely on suspicion. The petitioner is not named in FIR rather his name came into light in this case on the basis of confessional statement of co-accused,



namely, Pawan Yadav who said that petitioner is also involved in this alleged offence. It is also submitted that the allegation against the petitioner is that in his bank account, a sum of Rs. 25,000/- has been transferred by unknown person which is alleged to be looted one but in this regard, no any prove has come that the said amount is looted one. The petitioner has not been put on TIP till date and also he has got no criminal antecedent. Moreover, he is languishing in judicial custody since 27.03.2023.

Learned APP appearing for the state has opposed the prayer of regular bail.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case as well as custody of the petitioner, this court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be released on bail in connection with Parbatta P.S. Case No. 78 of 2022 on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M. IIIrd, Naugachia, Bhagalpur.
