- 2 04-08-2023 1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned A.P.P. for the State.
2. The petitioners apprehend arrest in connection with Sonapur P.S. Case No. 75 of 2023 registered under Section 307 and other allied sections of the Indian Penal Code.
3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that petitioners is innocent and have falsely been implicated in the present case. There is no specific allegation against the petitioners. Further he submits that the petitioners are members of the mob.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioners be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of



the like amount each to the satisfaction of C.J.M., Saran at Chapra in connection with Sonepur P.S. Case No. 75 of 2023, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
