Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned APP for the State.

Petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with
Mairwa P.S. Case No. 127 of 2022 registered for the offences
punishable under Sections 25(1-b)a, 26 and 35 of Arms Act.

As per the prosecution, while the informant along
with other police personnel were on regular patrolling duty
apprehended this petitioner and from the possession of this
petitioner one loaded country-made pistol and a cartridge were
recovered.

The main submissions advanced by learned counsel
Mr. Prafull Chandra Thakur appearing for the petitioner are that

in actual the petitioner was arrested by the police from his house but not at the alleged place mentioned in the FIR, though against him, five other cases are also running but he has got bail in all the said cases and in the present matter he has been languishing in jail since 29.03.2022.

Learned APP Mr. Arun Kumar Singh appearing for the State has opposed the bail prayer.

Considering the above submissions and mainly the period of custody undergone by the petitioner and also the fact that in the FIR, any other allegation except keeping the alleged fire-arms in his possession was not made against him, in the opinion of this Court the petitioner deserves to a lenient approach of this Court. Accordingly, let the petitioner named-above be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Court concerned in connection with Mairwa P.S. Case No. 127 of 2022.
