2 10-08-2023 Heard the parties.

2. The petitioner apprehend his arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 307 and other allied Sections of the Indian Penal Code.

3. Allegedly, the petitioner and other co-accused persons armed with various weapons assaulted the sons of the informant due to which they sustained injuries.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that petitioner is quite innocent and have committed no offence. He has been falsely implicated in this case. No such occurrence, in the manner as alleged, has ever taken place. The allegation levelled against the petitioner is not specific rather general and omnibus in nature. He further submits that from the bare perusal



of the FIR, it is clear that there is no specific overt act against the petitioner and injuries are also of simple nature. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

5. Learned APP for the State opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

6. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case as the injury is of simple nature, let the above named petitioner, be released on bail, in the event of his/her arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/Successor Court in connection with Chainpur P.S. Case No.102 of 2023, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
