2. The petitioner has prayed for bail in a case registered for the offence punishable under sections 25(1-b)a, 26, 35 of the Arms Act.

3. Prosecution case relates to recovery of one loaded country made pistols and one live cartridge were recovered from possession of the petitioner.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. Police took signature on blank paper and later the same was manufactured as seizure list by the police officials. Provision of Section 100 CR.P.C. has not been followed by the police officials while preparing the seizure list. Petitioner has got no



criminal history and languishing in judicial custody since 23.11.2022.

5. The application for bail is opposed by learned APP for the State.

6. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. ten thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Nawada in connection with Warsaliganj P.S. Case No. 691 of 2022.
