ORAL ORDER

- 2 08-08-2023 1. Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to remove defect (s), as pointed out by the office, if any, within a period of four weeks on resumption of physical mode.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned A.P.P. for the State.
3. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Sultanganj P.S. Case No. 127 of 2023 dated 02.03.2023 registered for the offences punishable u/ss 394, 414 and 411 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25(1-b)a, 26, 35 of the Arms Act.



4. As per the prosecution case, when the informant was going to railway station, two persons boarded on motorcycle came and assaulted him with fists and slaps. They also snatched mobile phone and looted Rs. 500/- in cash and ran away. In the meantime, police came and apprehended the accused persons including this petitioner. On search, one deshi katta, two mobile phones were recovered from the co-accused person Bambam Kumar.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. Nothing incriminating material has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner is accused in one more criminal case as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 02.03.2023.

6. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

7. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Bhagalpur in connection with Sultanganj P.S. Case



No. 127 of 2023.

8. The application stands allowed.
